DESCRIPTION

Agarita Studio Addition 120 E Agarita San Antonio, Texas 78212

The project involves the addition of a bedroom with a carport below, designed to be subordinate to the existing home. The addition is thoughtfully placed at the rear of the house to take advantage of the natural grade drop. This allows it to sit lower, minimizing visibility from the street and preserving the historic streetscape.

The proposed design seeks a variance to locate the new bedroom addition at a split-level above a new carport along the south alley. This approach avoids placing the addition directly above the existing residence, which would conflict with the historic Arts & Crafts character, encroach upon the mature oaks, and impose on the neighbors on either side of the 50-foot lot.

The addition incorporates key design elements such as a shake shingle façade, a red standing seam metal roof, painted wood trim, and exposed rafter tails. Though the exterior shingles and the hand crimped metal roof respond to the original Arts & Crafts structure, the shingles are cedar rather than redwood and will be differentiated by being left natural. The shingles at the stair hyphen at the stair will have 2"rather than 4" spacing. The galvanized steel support structure acknowledges the 21st century addition.





















West Exterior Elevation


