We are in need of a kitchen remodel and to make it work the most efficient way possible, we are requesting approval to move a (24x48) window from the SouthEast side of our kitchen to the west facing side of our kitchen and move a (36x80) aluminum/glass door.

-The Southeast facing kitchen window (24x48) to be cut out and placed where an existing exterior door (36x80) currently is. The cut out to be replaced by similar exterior wood material and painted the same color. 12" diameter Vent for the range hood needed hereon the exterior also. The purpose of moving and closing up this window is so we can move our stove to this side of the kitchen and add a vent hood and add cabinets on this wall.

-The window is to be salvaged and moved to where the existing door to the backyard is. We currently have an exit through the kitchen to the backyard which is not an optimal place to exit.

-The existing exit door (36x80) will be moved to where there is an existing small window looking out into the backyard which currently is in a pantry. This will create a better flow from the dining room whereby people will not need to go through the kitchen to access the backyard.
