Early Settlers

According to local historian Frances Kallison, the first Jew to settle in San Antonio was Prussian immigrant Louis Zork, who was living in the city with his wife Adele by 1847. Zork opened a store by 1851, later adding a wholesale operation. Zork's business was quite successful as by 1860 he had over \$50,000 in personal wealth. By 1867, Zork was a director of the San Antonio National Bank. Taking advantage of life in a small town with a burgeoning immigrant population, Zork was able to move quickly into civic and political leadership. He served as a city alderman from 1856 to 1857, and was elected treasurer of Bexar County, a position he held from 1856 to 1865.

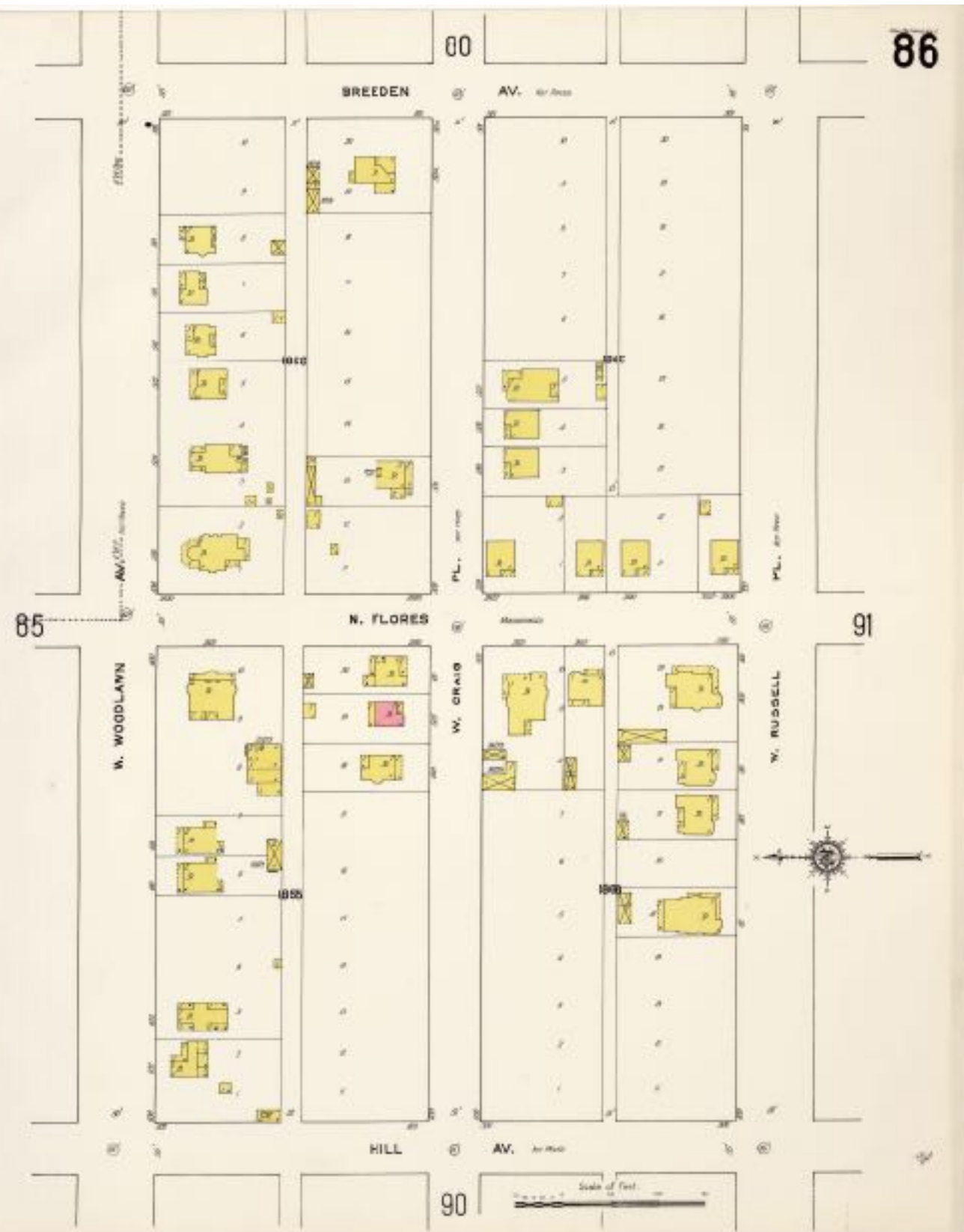
