1910 - Cannon

1910 - sold to Furnish (David K. (D.K.) Furnish was a prominent Texas cattle baron turned real estate developer who played a significant role in shaping San Antonio's northward residential expansion during the early 1900s .As the city grew beyond its traditional urban core—fueled by an economic boom and the rise of electric streetcar lines—Furnish stepped into the real estate arena to develop what were then considered San Antonio’s first "modern" planned suburbs.)

1910 - sold to W.C.Silliman

1913 - sold to J.W. and Elizabeth Etter

1916 - Zork Herbert and his wife, Joanna (One of its very first residents was Zork Herbert and his wife, Joanna. Zork was a German immigrant who arrived in the late 1800s, worked his way up through the local brewing industries, and eventually served as the Secretary-Treasurer of the historic **San Antonio Brewing Association**. He is the embodiment of the American Dream that built the backbone of this city.)

1923 - sold to H.A. and Ella Hodge (likely they built the houses on Lot 19 and Lot 20)

(A.H. Hodge (Arthur H. Hodge) was a prominent **San Antonio building contractor and developer** during the 1910s and 1920s. He and his wife, **Ella**, were active members of the city's social and business communities. Hodge ran a successful construction and contracting firm. He built major commercial properties and civic buildings during San Antonio's rapid boom period. He and Ella were involved in local civic groups. They frequently hosted social events that were covered by the society pages of the *San Antonio Express* newspaper.)

1929 - L.J. White

1937 - Mary Francis Smith

1947 - sold to Mrs. John James
